Guiding Tenets ©

- 1) Consciousness always finds its own form.
- 2) The form Consciousness finds is empty as it appears and full as it is.
- 3) As Consciousness finds its own form, it can actually disown territory and may lose or gain any implied parameters of personhood or otherness without acceptance or rejection. Though they are observed, nothing is gathered, nothing is held, nothing is rejected. This includes any and all forms, uniforms, or traditions of the Buddha's Dharma. In this way, the path is always open to be what it is, as it is. Consciousness always finds its own form. With and without status, with and without location.
